

**Road Sense** is the Lancashire Fire and Rescue Service Year 6 road safety package which looks at the transition from primary to high school. It is delivered by Fire Fighters and Community Safety Advisors.

The session is an hour long and is designed to help pupils to consider how they will travel to their new school safely and plan their route. It covers:

- The importance of wearing seatbelts and using appropriate car seats
- Safe cycling including wearing cycle helmets
- Pedestrian safety
- Be safe be seen
- Not causing a distraction when travelling in a car

Each child will be given a magazine to take home called “Way to Go” to help reinforce understanding at home and get parents involved with planning the transition.

This session is offered free of charge to every Yr 6 class across the county, Lancashire Fire and Rescue Service staff will contact schools to get booked in.
